<ul> <li>Safety on the A36 – InterRoute have produced a detailed report for the Highways Agency regarding safety on the A36 between Bath and Salisbury. The report referred to the meetings with Claverton Transport Committee and records consideration of a 50 mph speed limit over a stretch which includes Claverton Village. It was agreed that David will follow up the InterRoute report. Based on the reply from the Highways Agency, the committee will recommend what further action will be taken.         <ul> <li>It was agreed that the views of the Police will be sought regarding enforcement of a speed limit on the A36.</li> <li>It was agreed that David would respond to Prof. Alan Day's days letter offering Support, but declining financial support, in the fight to reduce the speed limit on the A36.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	David Richard David
<ul> <li>B&amp;NES proposed Park &amp; Ride at Bathampton meadows- The Parish Council have submitted its objections to the Park &amp; Ride proposals at Bathampton Meadows. It is expected that B&amp;NES Council will consider this in May. A letter will be prepared in readiness to request the Secretary of State to call in the application for Public Enquiry if needed.</li> <li>Other Transport Matters - The Link Road between the A46 and A36 still appears on transport plans and the Parish Council need to be vigilant over the next few years.</li> <li>Access onto A36 from the north of Claverton Village - David suggested that a mirror would be beneficial when using this access; a trial should be carried out</li> </ul>	David
