## Proposed reduction in Speed Limit on the A36 through Claverton

Thank you for your recent email following the discussions you have had with my colleague Stefan Chiffers regarding the current speed limit on the A36 through your village. I have discussed this matter with Cllr Roger Symonds and can confirm that:
