Cllr Mackintosh to follow up with J O'Rourke to understand if Appraisal can form basis of a Neighbourhood plan. Cllr Mackintosh to coordinate updating of appraisal and subsequent consultation within the Parish. Parish council to arrange for a planning officer to visit to advise/assist. | Mr Lippiatt has advised Parish Council in writing that he has notified BNES that he proposes to fell a tree (the Rowan by the post box) in the Claverton Conservation Area under a licence (red 018/76/14-15 and NGR ST 784646). The Parish wants the public to be formally consulted on the felling of the tree. Ms J Brewer, BNES will contact the Forestry Commission to enquire whether the application declared that the Rowan tree was in a Conservation Area.   |         |

| VPA / Highways meeting Cllr Beria attended a recent extraordinary meeting beween the VPA transport committee and Highways about forthcoming A36 closure. VPA were subsequently advised of imminent partial road closures. Clerk to inform residents via email. Parish Council still waiting for confirmation of starting date for the major works on A36 though it is likely to start in March 2015. No information yet on bus routes during work.   | LW      |

| Cllr Sykes asked Nick to maintain paths on an as-necessary basis   |         |
| Transportation Update, including actions arising re Warleigh Weir and issues re P&R option and possible A36/A46 link road  |         |
| A36/A46 link road. Cllr Beria reported that VPA will launch a campaign to promote the other side of the argument, highlighting the issues against the link.  |         |
| With regard to progress on the assessment of safety issues at Warleigh Weir, Cllr Sykes remains in contact with Mark Higgins. A draft ROSPA report has been produced but not yet released. The Parish Council will review the report when released, and there will be a stakeholder meeting to which PC and residents will be invited.   |         |
| Cllr Mackintosh advised cllrs that the University is continuing to actively advise its contractors that lorries must not use Claverton Hill, and undertook an investigation into the recent incidente of a lorry on the hill causing the road to be closed to traffic for several hours. The Cllrs are looking at ways of improving signage to prevent future incidents (see matters arising above).   |         |
