

Claverton Neighbourhood Plan Consultation

Please find time to read this document as it is important for the future development of Claverton.

You may recall towards the end of last year we circulated a questionnaire to all residents and interested parties within the Parish of Claverton asking what was important to them for the future of Claverton. In February 2018 we held an Open Public meeting where we shared the findings of the questionnaire as well as gaining further insight into how you would like to see the Parish in the future.

Since then, the Neighbourhood Plan Steering Committee has been working on developing our Vision and the Policies which will support this Vision. We now need to share these with you and seek your comments as part of the formal process which must be followed in developing a Neighbourhood Plan.

This document has been developed based on what we know today but plans for a number of years ahead. The full draft Neighbourhood Plan document can be found at www.clavertonpc.org on the Neighbourhood Plan page or copies will be available at one of the consultation sessions (please see below).

This final consultation will run for 6 weeks, from **Sunday 28th October to Sunday 9th December 2018**. During this period there will be three opportunities to come to a drop-in session at St Mary's Church where you will be able to ask for further clarification and share your thoughts with the community.

The drop-in sessions at St Mary's will be on

- **Tuesday 13th November 2018 6pm -7pm** prior to the monthly Parish Council Meeting. There will be some refreshments.
- **Saturday 24th November 2018 at 11am** (coffee, tea & cakes)
- On turn up **Tuesday 27 November 2018 from 7pm**

As well as making comments at any of the above meetings we would hope that every household would give us their views using the attached questionnaire and sending it to Vi Jensen at The Rectory Coach House, or electronically, by emailing the Parish Clerk (Lesley Watkinson) at clavertonpc@gmail.com The electronic version is on the website. Of course, you can make your views personally to members of the Steering Committee* who will be at the various drop in sessions.
