<p>9. Village Maintenance</p> <p>At the request of the Parish Council, Mr John Beresford inspected the two Village Benches. He advised that they are both in a reasonable state and do not require rebuilding. He proposed to thoroughly clean and sand all parts to remove existing flaky finish and expose the fresh timber , followed by two coats of external hardwax oil. He estimated the work to be one full day per bench (@£30p/hr), and will install two new fixing points into the concrete. He quoted £527.95 (of which £480 is labour) to complete the work.
